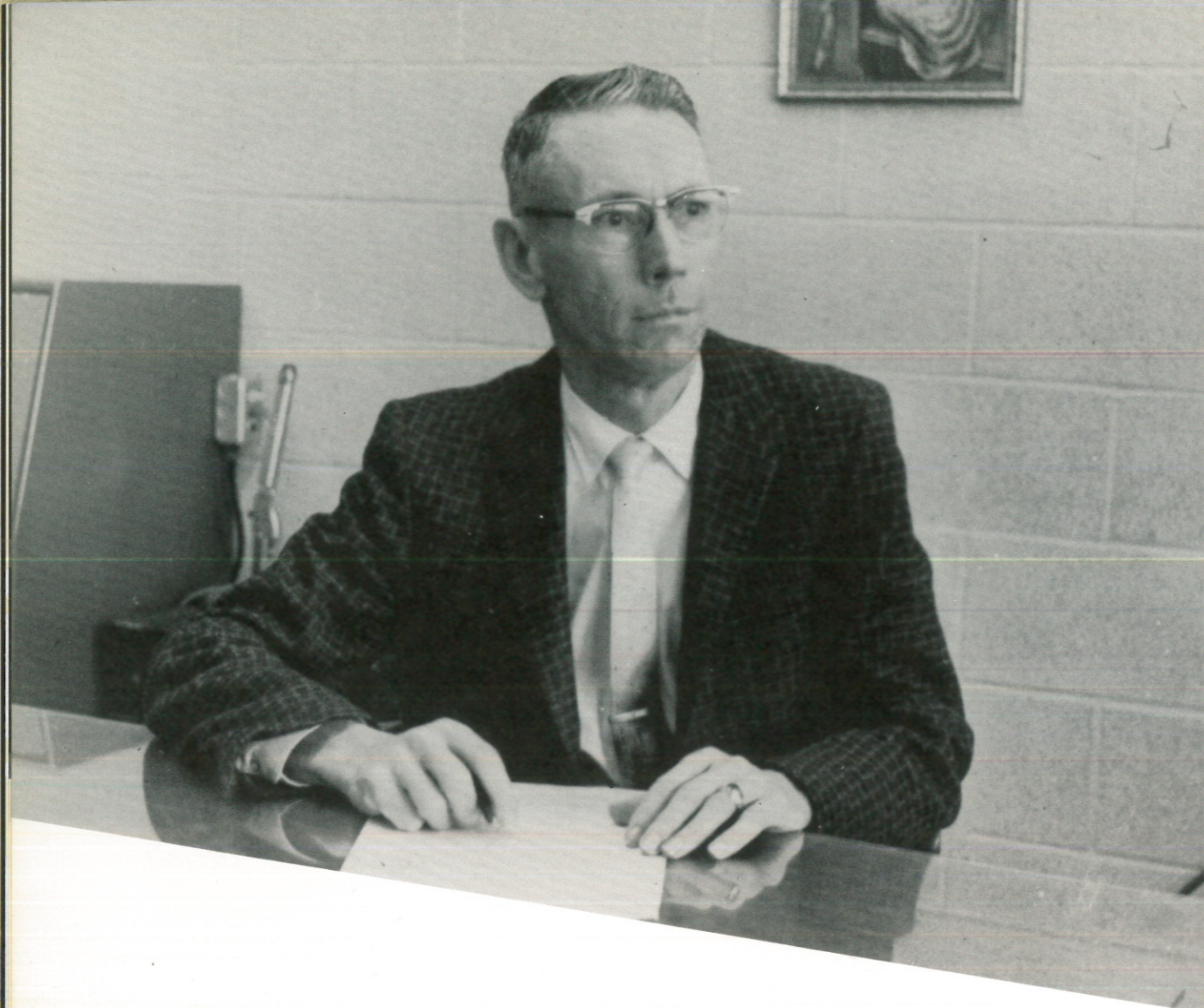


Students:
