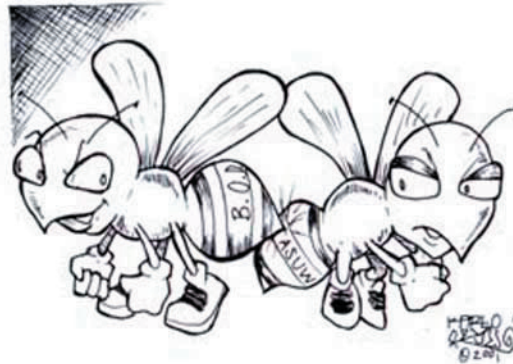

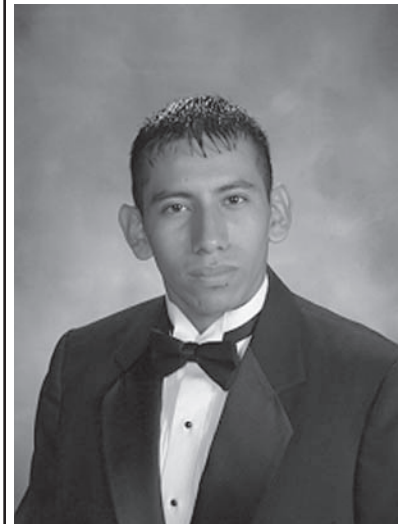
Senior Spotlight
