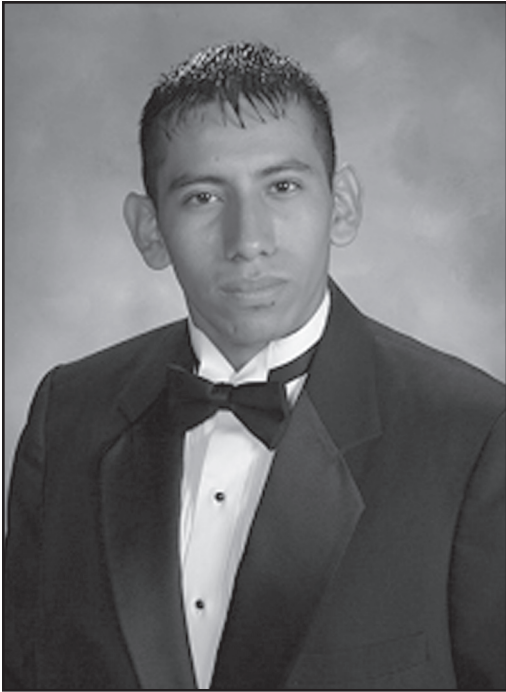


## I's Again... Band Advances to Area
