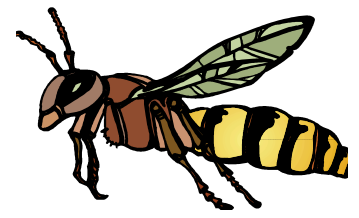

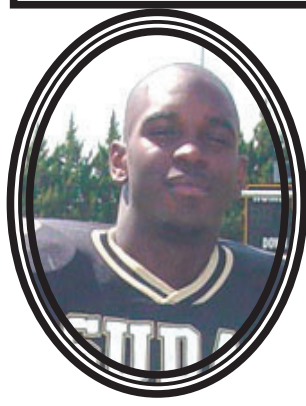


Junior High Basketball Action

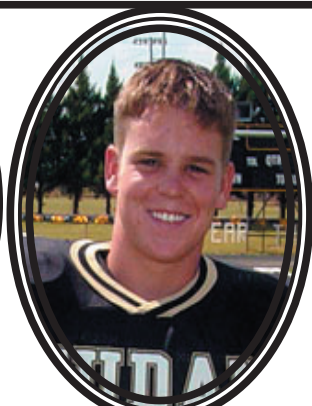

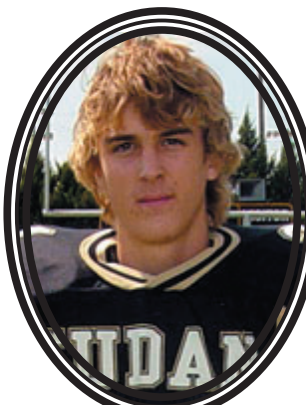
