Goal Line Stance Empowers Hornets to Beat Plains

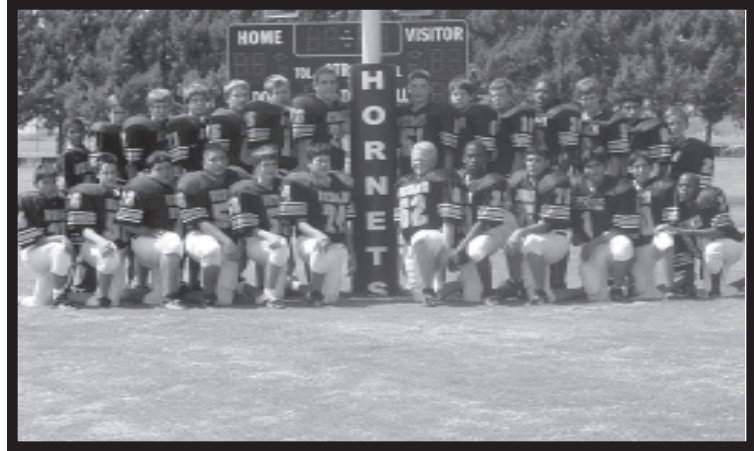
Final Score 20-7; 3 Hornet TD's Called Back
