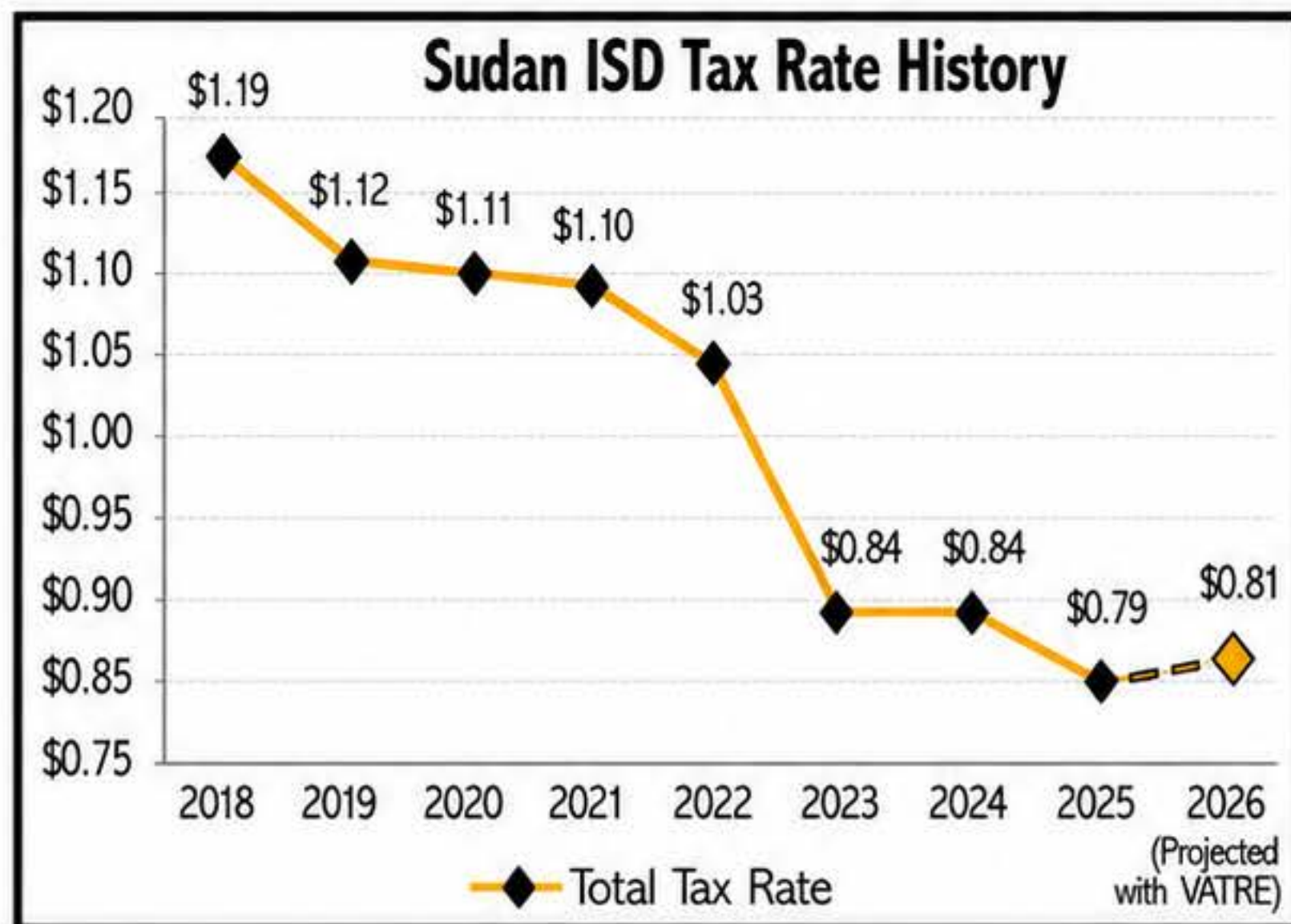

VOTER APPROVAL TAX RATE ELECTION

What is a VATRE?

A VATRE, or Voter Approval Tax Rate Election, is a special election that allows voters to decide whether a school district can increase its M&O tax rate above the state defined limit. If approved, the additional revenue can be used to support school operations, such as teacher and staff salaries, academic programs, and other operational needs.

1. If approved, will generate an estimated \$287,639 in additional revenue for the District.
2. If approved, will generate more operation dollars for the District that is not subject to recapture.
3. If approved, will result in additional revenue that will be used for everyday district operations.
