Sudan ISD offers career and technical education programs in Agriculture, Food, and Natural Resources; Architecture and Construction; Business Management and Administration; Finance; Hospitality and Tourism; and Human Services. Admission to these programs is based on student requests, course availability, and graduation plans.
